Behind the scenes, Dean's affinity for producing and recording vocals shines. His role as a vocal coach empowers talents to flourish, while his heart for pastoral care radiates hope for those in need.

Dean's lyrical resonance is felt within Grammy nominations and Dove Award nods. His co-write "Running" on The Martin's album earned Grammy recognition, while his contribution "Let Your Light So Shine" on Tiffany Coburn's "You Are More" album was Dove-nominated.

As one of the accompanists for Gaither Homecoming Artist Lynda Randle since 2014, Dean's piano artistry has enriched her timeless gospel classics.

In 2015, Dean embarked on a Kickstarter journey, birthing his debut solo album "Hope Found." The collaborative effort with top industry producers bore testament to his prowess.

Beyond the music, Dean's passions are an extension of his vibrant spirit. Cooking, traveling, and moments spent with loved ones and friends are threads woven into the fabric of his life.
